PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVES Needed - 1 (1 Inyo County)

To represent the Public Sector the qualified nominees shall be elected public officials, currently holding office, or their representative. Appointed public officials may be counted in meeting this requirement. The nominee must work or live in the designated county.

PRIVATE REPRESENTATIVE Needed - 1 (1-Inyo County)

To represent the Private Sector the qualified nominee shall be representative of private social service agencies, **law**, business, industry, labor, religious or other groups and interests. The nominee must work or live in the designated county.

LOW-INCOME REPRESENTATIVE Needed – 1 (1 Mono County)

To represent Low-Income Sector the qualified nominee need not be low-income themselves but shall have a thorough knowledge and understanding of the causes of poverty and needs of low-income individuals. The nominee must work or live in the designated county.
